COMMITTEES

1. Awards, Budget, Fund Raising, Archives, Information & Education, Meetings, Membership, Newsletter, Nominations, Producer Affairs, Professional Affairs, Public Affairs, Range Camp, Range Judging, Scholarship, Section Handbook, Student Affairs, Youth Activities, and Youth Forum.
2. Chair appointed by the President for one year. May be re-appointed.
3. Past President = Awards Chair.
4. President-Elect is Program Chair.

PURPOSE OF THE COMMITTEES

The primary purpose of the Committees are to promote the policies established by section by-laws, disseminate educational information on proper range management, develop goals and directions for the section, and organize section activities.

Structure

Each Committee shall be comprised of a Chair and a variable number of other members required establishing a functional Committee.

The President will appoint the Chair. Once a year the President will contact each Committee Chair to assess Committee progress and address future needs.

Operation

Committee Chairs will be responsible for organizing committees, meetings and reports. The President or Council will provide general direction.

Reports

The Chair will be responsible for reporting to the Section Council at annual meetings or upon request of the Council.
