PURPOSE

The Producer Affairs Committee is established to serve as an advisory body between the Council and producer segment of the Section. The Committee provides a means for discussion and evaluation of Section programs to insure a viable producer oriented program and membership. It also provides a forum for reporting activities, exchanging ideas and evaluating programs as they relate to the producers.

STRUCTURE

The Committee should be composed of active producer members or selected from the general members.

The Section President will appoint committee Chair. The Committee Chair will select committee members with the concurrence of the President. Committee members should be selected to give the widest coverage of the State.

FUNCTION

1. The duties and authority of the Committee are limited to advising, consulting and recommending actions and by such actions, serving as an effective liaison between the Council and the range users.
2. The Committee will become an ad hoc advisory committee to the summer meeting Local Arrangements Committee and the Annual Program Committee. The purpose is to advise on the kind of program and discussion pertinent to the present-day needs of the range users.
3. The Committee will be an active force in relating Section values to producer organizations and other producer oriented groups.
4. Serve on the Awards Sub-Committee - Excellence in Rangeland Stewardship.

Reports

A report of Committee activities will be submitted to the President prior to the Annual and summer meetings of the Section.

Meetings

The Committee should meet twice annually: (1) summer meeting, and (2) Annual meeting. Any Committee member may call special meetings.
