**PURPOSE**

This committee is responsible for promoting recruitment in the Wyoming Section and to retain from year to year those members who are currently active within the section.

**STRUCTURE**

The Wyoming Section President at the Annual Meeting appoints the Chair. Committee members are selected by the Chair in council with the President, other Officers, or Council and Section Members. Committee members should represent geographical regions and professions within or associated with range management in Wyoming. The Chair and committee members should be knowledgeable of the goals and benefits of membership of the Wyoming Section.

**FUNCTION**

Duties of Committee Chair:

1. To oversee the activities of the Membership Committee.
2. To contact delinquent members on a formal basis to request renewal of their membership.
3. To serve as Section representative to meetings of the Parent Society's Membership Committee.

Duties of Committee Members:

1. To motivate others within the Wyoming Section to actively solicit new membership whenever possible.
2. To develop and distribute membership and general information material concerning the Wyoming Section. To distribute to members and potential members any similar material developed by the Society.
3. To contact delinquent members on an informal basis with the purpose to reestablish membership.

Duties of the Newsletter Editor:

1. To print, when available, and as provided by the membership Chair, any item concerning membership with the Wyoming Section.

Duties of the President:

1. Forward member address changes received from the Lakewood, Colorado SRM Office to the membership committee Chair.
2. To support the Membership Committee in matters concerning their assigned responsibilities.
